VII. Discuss: MMAMTA Fall Workshop, August 2020 with Diane Hidy

- a. Before Covid-19, Diane Hidy was secured for August 21 concert and 22 Fall Workshop, both to take place at the First Baptist Church of Columbia. Concert would have been presented by the Odyssey Chamber Music Series in Columbia.
- b. Ayako has been in touch with Diane, who has retreated from San Francisco home to a more remote, secure location.
- c. As of April, Diane thought August was too early to travel, but will work with us as she is able.
- d. In case of liability, is MMAMTA insured through MTNA?
- e. Alternatively, postpone Fall Workshop to January 2021 (usually Odyssey presents Kids@Heart mid-month), or even July or August 2021.
- f. MMTA matching grant (MMTA - \$1000; MMAMTA is responsible to cover all costs, i.e. Hidy honorarium \$3000, traveling expenses ca. \$500 and Broadway Hotel accommodation ca. \$350) is technically valid until February 2021, but given the circumstances, we could ask for an extension.

Notes from the Winter Mtg: 2020 Fall Workshop

- a. Diane Hidy has been secured, for 8/21 (Fri) Tribute Concert (as Odyssey's Kids@Heart), and 8/22 (Sat) 9:30am-2pm Workshop at FBC First Baptist Church.
- b. 2020 Local Association Matching Grant Deadline for application is February 1. Hidy's \$3000 fee will be matched by MMAMTA (\$1500 MMAMTA, \$1500 MMTA) – or does it have to be \$2000/\$1000?
- c. Concern – Odyssey being an ensemble series, it would be in their best interest to have ensembles in our program. Attention Grabbers Book 3 (?) has a collaborative work that

might work; Piano Town series may include Teacher/Student collaboration. Repertoire suggestions?

- d. Program: Students mostly, aiming for 60 min of music (with intermission – or not?), plus Diane is willing to play something (not her own composition).
 - e. Odyssey requests all performers to submit their biographies. Because the children are involved, headshot will be optional, but the information must be uniform (everyone has a headshot, or none at all). They will also be asked to sign a disclosure of consent for Odyssey to record audio and video, and take photos to be used for its publicity purposes.
 - f. **Diane's agreed fee and requirements: \$3000 plus traveling expenses and a hotel accommodation.** As Odyssey guest, it would be possible to book Diane and her friend a hotel room at the Broadway across the street from First Baptist Church at a non-profit rate (ca. \$159 for \$179 rooms), tax free. For some reason that's a busy weekend in Columbia?? Better to book this now. (Odyssey can book, to be reimbursed later with the airfare.)
 - g. ***REVISED* PROPOSAL 2: Odyssey requests \$100** from MMAMTA for facility (\$50) and publicity support (\$250), and all donations, which will be used towards printing programs (usually \$600+). Odyssey will sell concession; separate table for Diane Hidy materials. **A volunteer is needed to sell Diane Hidy's merchandise.**
- VIII. Discuss 2020 / Review 2019 MMAMTA Preview Concert and MMTA Honors Concert
- a. 2020 MMAMTA will pay for the FBC rental fee, \$200 (need to check). With no added fee, more students will participate.
 - 1) 2019 MMTA Preview Concert was held at the Columbia College's Bix by Hall, September 15.
 - 2) 2019 MMTA Honors Concert I (1:30 and 3pm) was held at the Columbia College's Bixby Hall on October 27.
 - 3) 2019 MMTA Honors Concert II was held at the First Baptist Church on November 2, First Baptist Church.

- X. Discuss 2021: The 4th MMAMTA/Odyssey Pre-Collegiate Aria/Concerto Competition
- a. 2020 Winner: Anthony Wu, student of Natalia Bolshakova with Beethoven Piano Concerto No. 1, first movement. Performed brilliantly with Kreisler/Rachmaninoff arrangement as an encore.
 - b. MMAMTA contributed \$300, which covers the Judges' fees. (\$150 per judge, this year cellist Emma Hoeft and pianist Janice Wenger) **PROPOSAL 3: Odyssey requests \$300 support from MMAMTA.**
 - c. 2021 Baroque Concert this year is February 19, tentatively sponsored by the Paul D. Higday Mozart Trust. Due to C-19, Odyssey will keep our commitment flexible to best accommodate the performers and the public. If C-19 is still a problem, we will minimize the chamber ensemble to a second piano (facing each other) if necessary.
- XI. Discuss 2021: Plowman Chamber Music Festival – Master Classes
- PROPOSAL 4: Odyssey requests \$500 support from MMAMTA.** This year: Piano, Cello and Horn.

The details that were finalized before Covid are as follows:

Auditions: Saturday, October 31st - all day as usual, in the Choral Hall at the new Siquel Music Center on the University campus.

Audition fees: Same as 2019, \$25 per student.

Performance: Sunday November 15th, 4:00 pm at the Missouri Theatre.

Covid Impact:

The League Executive Committee met by Zoom last week and asked that I contact the teachers who generally participate in the Showcase to obtain their best thoughts on proceeding with the event. The Showcase more than any other event the League sponsors can require and provide the following: social distancing by proper planning the check-in and the auditions and the performance; require use of masks; have hand sanitizer available; and sanitize the keyboard (as allowed by the host site) between performers.

However we would like the teachers input - Will this be enough that you will feel comfortable having children audition for the Showcase?

If you have a chance to discuss at MMAMTA, that would be wonderful, but I do plan to send an email direct to each teacher who had students audition last year.

Full packet of information was being developed before I left for vacation in late February and with the Covid and so many uncertainties since then, plans have been on hold. But based on the League Executive Committee support, we plan to return to planning.

Auditions fees will not change; audition space will not change unless MU closes all performance halls; the Performance may move from the Missouri Theatre, frankly due to the high cost and our desire to remain fiscally conservative this year.

If our input is positive about having the 2020 Showcase, the full packet of information will be available early July. If any decisions are made to change the location of the Showcase or to actually cancel the event, I will let you know as soon as the decision is made.

As always we greatly appreciate your assistance in posting and distributing the information for the Showcase and again, thank you so much for asking for this information.
